
















Türkiye has a global market access at the nexus of Europe, Asia and Africa, thus creating an efficient and costeffective hub to major markets.

SUCCESSFUL ECONOMY

 from CIT, a grant on employer's social security
 share, as well as land allocation





- Well-developed and low-cost sea transport facilities, Railway transport advantage to Central and Eastern Europe






Türkiye | Qualified Labor Force Scores










BASBAŞ Layout Plan | Lease Options





Application Steps for BASBAŞ Free Zone

FILL OUT

• The Operating License Application Form is filled, its attachments are prepared and submitted to the Western Anatolia Free Zone Directorate.

MAKE AN APPLICATION

 It is sent to the Ministry of Trade for license approval. After the evaluation of the application, the company receives a letter of conformity.

SET UP A

 Company/branch establishment procedures are completed within 30 days, a lease agreement is drawn up at BASBAŞ.

ACQUIRE A

 An Operating License is issued by the Ministry of Trade and sent to the company.
